Sub: Extension of Medical facilities to the retired employees covered under New Pension Scheme (NPS) on par with other retired employees covered under Old Pension Scheme - Reg.

- Ref:** 1) Representations received from the retired employees covered under New Pension Scheme (NPS).
2) O.M. No.S.11011/10/2012-CGHS(P)/EHS, issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, EHS Section, Govt. of India, dated 28.03.2017.
3) The resolution of the 35th Meeting of the Executive Council held on 04.03.2022.

In pursuance of the resolution of the Executive Council at its 35th Meeting held on 04.03.2022, the Medical facilities are extended to all the retired employees and their dependents covered under New Pension Scheme (NPS) on par with the other retired employees covered under Old Pension Scheme, on payment of monthly contributions as detailed below:

(i) Monthly Contributions for availing CGHS facility:

Sl.No.	Corresponding levels in the pay matrix as per 7 th CPC	Contribution (Rs. Per month)
1.	Level: 1 to 5	Rs.250/-
2.	Level: 6	Rs.450/-
3.	Level: 7 to 11	Rs.650/-
4.	Level: 12 and above	Rs.1000/-

(ii) Entitlement of wards in private hospitals empanelled under CGHS:

Sl.No.	Corresponding Basic Pay drawn by the Officer in 7 th CPC	Ward Entitlement
1.	Up to Rs.47,600/-	General
2.	Rs.47,601/- to Rs.63,100/-	Semi-Private
3.	Rs.63,101/- and above	Private

The minimum years of qualifying service for obtaining the University Medical ID Card should be of 10 years.

No minimum qualifying years of service for obtaining the University Medical ID Card in case of death/disability.

The beneficiaries and their family members, as per the above levels, have an option to get the University Medical ID Card by paying an annual contribution for 12 months or by making a lump-sum contribution for 10 years with lifetime validity.


If it is difficult to the beneficiary to pay in lump-sum, they have to pay contributions in advance for a block period of 6 months i.e. **January – June** or **July to December** and so on till the facilities are availed.

If he/she starts availing of the Medical facility from a month in between, he/she shall have to pay contribution on proportionate basis, upto next June or December, as the case may be.

The mode of payment should be through a Bank Draft/Challan in favour of the Registrar, EFLU, Hyderabad for obtaining a University Medical ID Card.

This is applicable to all the NPS employees who will be retiring in future also.

Other conditions such as definition of family, CGHS contributions, conditions of dependency etc. will be applicable as per existing rules.
