In continuation of the University Circulars under Ref. i & ii, in view of certain resolutions passed in the 12<sup>th</sup> Academic Council under Ref. iii, and as per the G.O under Ref. iv, as a precautionary measure against the spread of the novel Coronavirus and to ensure Social Distancing, the University has taken the following decisions:

- The online mode of teaching for regular courses will continue till 29 April, 2020, i.e., till the last day of instruction (as per the existing time tables).
- Teachers will continue the classes, Comprehensive Continuous Assessment (CCA) and other academic activities online, as per the Academic Almanac, while the students of the UG, PG, PGDTE, PGDTA, and B.Ed courses are advised to make optimum use of the online facility.
- The Academic Calendar will be followed for submission of internal assessment grades in the Office of the Controller of Examinations.
- Ph.D. course work/guidance shall continue to be offered online.
- Ph.D. viva voce examinations will be conducted online until further orders.
- End-semester examinations will be conducted through the online mode from 05 to 13 May, 2020, as per the University Academic Almanac.
- Hostels of the Indian students will remain closed until further orders.
- Students are not required to be present on the Campus for rest of the academic year of 2019-2020 as a precautionary measure.

9. All the measures currently being followed for the health and security of the foreign students will be continued.
10. The teaching and non-teaching staff will continue to work from home until further orders.
11. The other relevant instructions and guidelines of the University Circulars under Ref. i & ii are valid until further orders.
12. The instructions and guidelines will be continuously revisited by the University Administration to determine any further course of action. Hence, the teaching and non-teaching staff, and students are advised to visit the University website from time to time for further updates.
