Procedure for application:

Please print the application form (**6 pages**) **back to back**. Fill it up with the correct details. Please enclose with your application form a demand draft for an amount of Rs.500/- (Rs.250/- for SC/ST) towards the cost of the application form and another demand draft for the total programme fee for PGCTE. That is, an Indian citizen living in India should send **two** crossed demand drafts: one for Rs.500/- (Rs.250/- for SC/ST) and one for Rs.5700/- (Rs.3450/- for SC/ST) along with the filled-in Internet application form to **'The Dean, School of Distance Education, The English and Foreign Languages University, Hyderabad-500007'**.

The demand drafts should be drawn in favour of **'The Registrar, EFL University'**.
