Sub: Revised Academic Calendar - UGC guidelines dated 29 April 2020 adapted – Reg.

Ref: UGC letter: D.O.No.F.1-1/2020 (Secy), dated 29 April 2020— Guidelines on examinations and academic calendar for the Universities in view of COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent lockdown.

The Academic Council of the University at its 13th Meeting (Emergency Meeting) conducted through the online mode on Saturday, 02 May, 2020, discussed the guidelines issued by the UGC cited under reference above, and unanimously resolved to adapt the guidelines as under to suit the needs of the University:

2. The duration of the end-semester examination for each course stands reduced from three to two hours. Students are required to complete the examination in two hours and submit their answers to the teacher concerned, through the online mode, immediately after the examination.
3. Final semester students who wish to improve their grades in the subjects concerned will be given a one-time chance to do so in the following semester, whenever the University conducts examinations either online or offline depending on the situation. The information regarding the grade improvement examination schedule will be posted on the University's website only and will not be conveyed by email or by any other means whatsoever.
4. PhD scholars, whose terms for submission of their PhD theses prescribed under relevant Ordinances of the University have expired or are going to expire during the Corvid-19 pandemic, will be allowed to submit their theses, and complete all pending formalities, within six months from the date of expiry of the regular prescribed period. The guidelines adopted herein are applicable also to those students who are yet to submit their theses.
5. All the decisions mentioned in Circulars dated 31 March, 2020 and 12 April, 2020 are valid unless they are superseded by the decisions made in the Academic Council meeting held on 02 May, 2020.

Students are advised to visit the University's website regularly for updates.
