## UNIVERSITY MUSIC CLUB

As part of the Vice Chancellor's endeavours to enrich the cultural and social life of the EFLU community, the University Music Club has been created. It is housed on the first floor of the Publications building. The Club invites the students and teaching and non-teaching staff to become members.

The following are the guidelines:

- 1. The Music Club will offer courses in playing different instruments. Each course will have a maximum of ten members on a first-come-first-served basis.
- 2. The Club will be open on all days from **8 am to 8 pm**, except **Wednesdays**, with a break between **1 pm and 3 pm**.
- 3. Teaching and non-teaching staff can access the Club only between **8 am** and **9 am**.
- 4. A full-time student, teaching- and non-teaching staff can join the Club by applying. However, right to admission is reserved. Any form of indiscipline or misbehavior will attract punitive measures.
- 5. Members who have enrolled in the Music Club will be issued an identity card. They have to produce it to the authorized personnel as and when they are asked to.
- 6. Members of the Club will have to sign in an attendance register during entry and exit.
- 7. Members are expected to maintain decorum in the Club.
- 8. Members are required to keep the Club litter-free.
- 9. Members should leave their footwear outside.
- 10. Mobile phones should be either switched off or in silent mode.
- 11. No smoking, eating, and drinking will be allowed inside the Club.
- 12. If any instrument is damaged, it is the member's responsibility to get it repaired immediately to the satisfaction of the authorities. In case the instrument is damaged beyond repair, the member should either replace it with a new one or pay its market price.
