3. After the possible overlapping is eliminated, your suggestions will be accordingly approved and you can start writing on the book in not more than 100 words in the MLA format. If the entry is in a foreign language, the matter should be translated into English also.
4. Should there be any overlaps of books or articles, the coordinator will take care of it and inform you.
5. By November end, 2018 the works should be sent to the coordinator for editing and publication.
