COURSE DESCRIPTON:

C13: Text Kanji and Grammar-VI

This course will use some representative texts like newspaper reports, magazine articles, essays and fiction to enable students to read and understand advanced level Japanese language and facilitate an understanding of Japanese culture. Also, depending upon the requirements of the class, contemporary juvenile literature and novellas will also be introduced.

C14:Oral Expression IV
