Course Title: Reading and Writing

Course Description

This course is an attempt to introduce young learners to the nuances, challenges, and delights of

academic reading and writing. They will be introduced to the demands of the academy, will be

taught to read and write according to its expectations. The Course will cover issues pertaining to

punctuation and its uses, different kinds of reading strategies, and how to deploy them. Writing

will be taught from the basics, and the techniques of producing good written material will be

discussed. The course will use various genres in teaching the two skills—reading and writing.

These can be any materials from newspaper reports to literature. There will be a significant

amount of practical work with learners practicing close reading, and getting extensive practice in

writing.

Evaluation Scheme

There will be internal examinations (40%) and an end-of semester examination (60%) taken in
