Submissions that address current debates, emerging trends, and challenges in the field of language education are especially welcome.

Themes

The forthcoming issue of *Languaging* invites original and critical contributions on **technology and artificial intelligence in English language education**, including but not limited to:

- Artificial intelligence in the ELT classroom: tools, applications, and implications
- Generative AI (e.g., ChatGPT, Copilot) for writing, speaking, and assessment
- Automated feedback and intelligent tutoring systems for language learners
- Digital pedagogies: blended learning, flipped classrooms, and online language teaching
- Virtual reality (VR), augmented reality (AR), and immersive environments for English learning
- Corpus linguistics and data-driven learning in technology-mediated settings
- Teacher preparedness and professional development for AI-integrated language teaching
- Ethical considerations, bias, and academic integrity in AI-mediated ELT
- Technology for inclusive and multilingual language education
- Social media, digital storytelling, and learner engagement
- Critical perspectives on technology: access, digital divide, and decolonial approaches

Types of submissions

• Research articles

In-depth theoretical, review-based, or empirical papers critically engaging with literature, methodology, and implications for practice.

Word count: 5000 words (including references)

• Book reviews

Critical evaluations of recent books in ELT or Applied Linguistics that situate the work within relevant academic discourses.

Word count: 1000 words

• Interviews

Edited Q&A-style interviews with ELT or Applied Linguistics experts, thematically organised and professionally transcribed.

Word count: 2500 words

• Research dissemination

Practice-oriented summaries of PhD research that translate academic findings into practical insights for educators.

Word count: 1500 words

Submission guidelines

A. First page of the manuscript

The first page of the manuscript should have the following information:

- ▶ Title
- ▶ List of authors
- ▶ Authors' affiliated organisations
- ▶ Email address(-es)
- ▶ Short author bio-note (50 words)
- ▶ Abstract: 150-200 words
- ▶ 5 to 6 keywords

B. Manuscript formatting and style

- Use APA style (7th edition) for in-text and end-of-text referencing.
- Use British spelling, following the Concise Oxford English Dictionary.
- Use Times New Roman, 12-point font, 1.5 line spacing.
- Do not indent the first line of each paragraph; use two hard returns between paragraphs.
- Use Word heading styles (e.g., Heading 1, Heading 2) to indicate different levels of headings.
- Submit all manuscripts in MS Word (doc/docx) format.
