- 1. Write two tasks for each of the methods given below: (1000-1200 words)
  - i. Direct method
  - ii. Audio-lingual
  - iii. Silent way
  - iv. Community language learning
  - v. Content-based instruction

Explain how these tasks reflect the salient features of the methods that include:

- a. Learning approach
- b. Purpose of teaching language,
- c. The roles of teachers and learners,
- d. Elements and/or skills of language emphasized,
- e. Role of first language
- f. Role of errors in the process of language learning
- Define approach, design and procedure with reference to Communicative language teaching. How do you think CLT has changed the ELT scenario? Explain with examples comparing and contrasting the ELT classrooms before and after CLT. (500-600 words)
