The PGDTE 2020 examinations will be conducted online for all the courses. Different courses will have different formats for the

online examinations, and you will be made aware of the pattern of the examinations during the course of the contact classes

by the teachers/course monitors concerned. Sample question papers (in each subject) will be emailed to you on November 2, 2020.

When attending the PGDTE CP classes online, please make sure that you have the following with you:

- 1. Complete set of the PGDTE materials of the courses you have opted
 - 2. Your corrected assignment responses (first deadline assignments) you will receive the second deadline assignments once they are evaluated and monitored.
 - 3. A list of your doubts/queries in each of the courses opted for.
 - 4. A dictionary (Oxford Advanced Learners' Dictionary/Macmillan's/Longman's/Cambridge) and an English

Pronouncing Dictionary by Daniel Jones if you've opted for The Phonetics of English/TLL.

Verification of Original Certificates

Please make sure that you are in possession of the following certificates/documents in **ORIGINAL**:

- i. Your SSC (Class X) certificate for verification of name, Father's name and date of birth.
- ii. Your original Aadhaar card, PAN card or Passport for verification of your identity.

Your name on the Identity card should match EXACTLY with the name in our records.

iii. SC/ST certificate (if applicable)

iv. Visually Challenged or Physically Challenged certificate (if applicable)

v. Change of Name certificate (if applicable - Gazette Notification)

We will let you know very soon when and how the verification of these certificates will be carried out.

A special ONE TIME provision for those who are unable to attend the Online Contact programme-cum-examinations:

We understand that not every one of you might be comfortable doing the classes online or taking the exams online. We, therefore,

have a special provision for you.

- If you are eligible to attend the Online PGCTE Contact Programme-cum-Examinations 2020 but do not attend the same or do not take the exams online - due to infrastructure issues or lack of confidence in taking the exams online, you will be invited to attend the PGCTE Contact Programme-cum-Examinations 2021 and take the exams face to face next year (November 2021) without having to pay any fees.
- This is a special one-time provision for all participants who were eligible for the Online PGDTE Contact Programme-cum-Examinations 2020 but do not attend the same.

- We encourage you to complete the contact programme and the examinations online this year, in November 2020.
- In 2021, there may not be an online option, and you will have to take leave from your work place and travel to Hyderabad to complete the course.
- Also, accommodation in the University hostels next year may be subject to availability.
