1. Why is 'RBI90Quiz' being organised?

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) was established under the RBI Act 1934 and commenced operations on April 1, 1935. This year marks the 90th anniversary of the establishment of the Bank. To celebrate this momentous occasion, a nationwide quiz titled 'RBI90Quiz' is being organised.

2. Eligibility:

Undergraduate students who are not more than 25 years of age as on September 01, 2024 (i.e., those born on or after September 01, 1999) and pursuing bachelor's degree across any stream of study through recognised universities/colleges located in India.

3. Coverage of the quiz:

The quiz will be on general knowledge topics like current affairs, history, literature, sports, economy, finance, RBI, etc.

4. Modalities:

The quiz is conducted in the following framework:

Phase I (Online Round): A nationwide online quiz will be conducted on designated date(s)/time. There will be 36 multiple choice questions to be answered in 15 minutes.

Phase II (State Round): The top 90 teams from first round in the State will compete at in-person quiz conducted at State level.

Phase III (Zonal Round): The winner emerged from State round will compete with best teams of other States grouped as a Zone.

Phase IV (National Round): The Zonal winners will compete in the National finals.

5. Prizes:

6. Registration for the quiz:

- Visit <https://www.rbi90quiz.in>. Students are required to register for the quiz as a team of two students from the same college i.e., two students per team. **There is no restriction on the number of teams that can register from a college** i.e., any number of teams can participate from a college in first round. The list of colleges is available in the drop down menu. All participants will get participation certificate. The colleges with most participation will be recognised.
- Registration is free of charge. Last date of registration is up till 9 PM on September 17, 2024. Any change of dates/timing will be updated on the website.

- c. **In case a college is not found in the drop down, it is advised to check under the name of erstwhile District.** Eg. IIT Hyderabad, which currently falls under Sangareddy District, is being shown under Medak District in the portal. College officials can request for registration of their college by visiting 'colleges' tab in the website. Alternatively, it is advised to approach Team RBI90Quiz through contact@rbi90quiz.in. Notification via email will be sent when their college is added to the registration list.
- d. Both team members must provide their individual names, gender, date of birth (as mentioned in Class X certificate), email ID, mobile number, and Student ID number (if ID Card has not been issued, the number mentioned on the bonafide certificate/authority letter/ validation letter/ authorization letter issued by the college/university must be provided). These credentials will be verified if the team is selected for the subsequent rounds and if found incorrect/incomplete, will lead to disqualification.
- e. Upon filling the requisite fields, and post verification of the same, both team members will receive an auto-generated team code (same code). The team can use this code to log in with their password on the designated day/s for the online quiz.

7. Online Quiz schedule

The online quiz may take place post September 17, 2024 for registered teams and hence, it is advised to keep track of e-mails/ rbi90quiz.in website for date(s) of online quiz. Each team can participate in the quiz only once. Both team members must attempt the quiz together on a single device i.e., mobile phone, tablet, laptop, or desktop computer.

8. Online Quiz format

- a. This is a timed quiz with 36 multiple choice questions of varying difficulty levels and 25-second time limit to answer each question. (Total Quiz duration: 15 minutes). Teams with visually impaired student/s will be granted additional 25 seconds per question resulting in a total quiz time of 30 minutes.
- b. The questions will be available in Hindi and English. Each correct answer earns 1 point. There are no penalties for incorrect answers.
- c. Students can attempt periodic sample quizzes posted on the platform, and these will not require any special code to participate.

9. Selection for subsequent rounds:

- a. In case of teams qualifying through the online quiz, expenses related to travel and stay for the subsequent rounds will be borne by RBI subject to internally fixed limits.
- b. In case of teams qualifying for the subsequent round, verification of information submitted by them at the time of registration will be carried out. If any discrepancies are observed, it will result in disqualification.
