Proposals for the in-person conference are invited in two categories:

Individual papers:

Presentations on original research by one or more authors. Presentations will typically last 20 minutes (15 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for discussion).

Posters:

Poster sessions will be organized to showcase work-in-progress, fieldwork & results of empirical research. Poster presenters will be provided with a specific area & time for the presentation and discussion of their posters. Posters should be in the size of DIN A1 or A0 in portrait format.

BACKGROUND

Multilingualism is woven into the tapestry of the linguistic landscape Assame of India. The use of a variety of languages to achieve both social and pedagogic communicative functions has been a feature of communication in pre- and post-colonial India. In recent years however, the growing translocation of people across the globe has led to an increased interest in the multilingual learner's language repertoire, language teaching and learning methodologies, educational policies in multilingual contexts and so on. Research is now showing that multilingual education advantages learners by: (1) improving their cognitive abilities; (2) promoting greater linguistic proficiency across multiple languages; (3) raising cultural awareness and fostering an understanding of cultural diversity; (4) raising academic success in language and content-related areas; (5) equipping learners with skills like problem-solving, multitasking and intercultural communication skills; and (6) promoting equity, empathy and tolerance. As language educators and teacher trainers in multilingual contexts, we are aware of the various challenges that

multilingual education poses: lack of teacher training, heterogenous classrooms, insufficient materials and resources to

address diverse learner needs, language hierarchy in society and in the classroom, issues in curriculum and syllabus
